



Overseas practice declaration

Being a medical practitioner registered with the Medical Council of Ireland, I hereby declare that for the period 1st May 2013 to 30th April 2014, I have not practised more than a total of 30 days in Ireland and for this reason reasonably believe there is no reason for the Medical Council to satisfy itself as to the ongoing maintenance of my professional competence as if I were established in the State.

Furthermore, I understand that practising medicine outside the State while retaining registration with the Medical Council does not exempt me from the legal duty under Section 94 of the Medical Practitioners Act 2007 for medical practitioners registered with the Medical Council to maintain professional competence.

I am providing herewith supporting documentation to evidence my maintenance of professional competence pursuant to my legal duty under the Medical Practitioners Act 2007 and in line with Medical Council standards and guidelines. I understand that if I practise medicine more than 30 days in the State, the Medical Council will regard this as being established in Ireland.
