Maximum **5** Professional Development Plan (PDP) credits / hours

Doctors not engaged in the practice of medicine (as declared to the Irish Medical Council and the College of Psychiatrists of Ireland):

Total: minimum **50 CPD credits / hours**, broken down as follows -
Minimum **20** Accredited Continuing Education (ACE) credits / hours
Minimum **25** Work-Based Learning (WBL) and/or Practice Review (PR) credits / hours
Maximum **5** Professional Development Plan (PDP) credits / hours
